The center will feature an area designed to care for the needs of residents requiring a short-term rehabilitation stay and a separate space designed to meet the needs of traditional, long-term care geriatric residents.

The 95,182 sq. ft. facility also will feature a library, recreational areas, lounges, family visitation rooms with anti-viral technology, a full service salon, and outdoor courtyard. Several dining venues and options will cater to the various needs of the residents, including 24-hour room service and a menu created by an executive chef that will be on staff. Additionally, the entire facility will be backed up by emergency power.
